Dorothy "Dot" Hoffman Schadel, 88, of Dalmatia, passed away at home on September 14, 2024, surrounded by her family. She was born in Jackson Twp, Halifax, PA on November 9, 1935, a daughter of the late Margaret P. and Robert L. Hoffman.

Dot was a very active member at St. Luke's UCC of Malta, where she served as a Sunday School Director, Bible School Director and a member of the Church Choir, which she loved. She also stepped up as a leader in the kitchen at the Gratz Fair and for events at the Church. Dot was president of the Women of the Susquehanna Charge (WOSC) for a number of years. Dot and Butch were co-owners of Schadel's Service Station in Dalmatia for 30 years while expanding through the creation of RDS Auto Supplies.
