Kenneth E Schlegel, 98, of Dalmatia, passed away on December 7, 2024, at the Brookdale Grayson View Assisted Living, Selinsgrove. He was born in Northumberland on October 2, 1926, the son of the late Mary and Mark Schlegel.

He was a member of Trinity United Church of Christ, Dalmatia, served on the Cemetery Board and Church Consistory. Kenneth was also a 32nd Degree Mason of Herndon Lodge 702, Harrisburg Scottish Right, Tall Cedars Millersburg Forest 125, a Lower Mahanoy Township Supervisor for 50 years, member of Three Pine Acres Hunting Camp in Potter County, Fiddlers Run Sportsman's Association, Hickory Corners Fire Company, NRA, and the State Horticultural Association of PA Fruit Growers.
