I got a happy birthday balloon 4 u intending to write a bunch of messages on 4 u, take to ur grave & let it go until I could no longer see it...this was taught to me by a friend who was in the same situation as us, only the roles they played were reversed...he said once I could no longer see it, meant that it had arrived in heaven safely in ur loving hands...i may have told u about how I would do this for dad...well, I procrastinated, like I usually do, & never got there 4 ur bday..i haven't been there much at all..mom says that would hurt u, but I don't think so...i think you would totally understand! I sometimes tend to think I know u better than mom...it just hurts sooo flippin much 2 know u r right there under the ground, & I just feel like I really need to see u one more time! I'm so glad that mom & I decided to have ur pic on the front of the tombstone...at least I can c u when I talk to u...mom of course goes up every week...she even cleans off ur stone & gardens around ur plot...God love her! She is a mess too, its just so hard to accept! Especially the way in which u hadda go, & all the shitty things u hadda go thru during ur 3 year fight...wat a fight it was! I can only hope ur treasures in heaven r even greater for all u hadda endure...it does give me sum peace to know u r with dad & memmy again....ur buddies Gary & Rick, & who ever else u loved that I may not have had the pleasure of knowing...i got a little off track, another thing I know how to do well..lol...so, the balloon is here in my woman cave, slowly losing its ability to reach u...so I thought I made up my mind I was gonna go another day, just a few days later, so I bought a plain balloon, red, at Dollar general. Its July 12th, & that 1 shares a spot alongside the bday 1. Its not only going to the grave that stops me from not leaving the house, its the severe depression I am in, ur journey to death being at the top of the list, but a dozen other things as well...i know wat u told me about my depression just a few short days b4 ur death, & I totally agree! U know me so well, probably better than anyone else, so u know how much I hate change, starting over, etc., but in the next

breath, picture myself thru with it all & living the very best life since the late 80's, early 90's...the only thing that would make it absolutely fabulous is u here to share it with me...i know in my heart of hearts, if r roles had been reversed, u would feel as I do right now, just easier for you to hide cuz ur so quiet & always did an amazing job at keeping ur emotions in check....for ur death anniversary, I again wanted to go to ur grave & take both balloons up (2 make mama happy..lol), but again continued to sit, but played sad music that reminded me of u & r sibling bond & cried for a great man taken way too soon! Then I said the hell with this, I'm gonna play some roadhouse blues by ur fave group, non other than the Doors, & instead of bringing me peace & perhaps a smile, ended up crying more than when the sad music was playing...go figure...i guess cuz there's more of an emotional attachment to that song, so many awesome memories! People have been awesome during my shattering grief (most) & I know everyone means well in their sincerity, but the common phrase, that I, myself have used often, "remember they r in r thoughts and memories, so they aren't really gone", just doesn't help me...sure,no will keep ur memory alive & honor the great, hard working man u r til my days here on earth are done, & yes, it does give me peace, but I want u here, not a memory, u! But reality, being the pain in the ass it is, reminds me I can't have u, nor can I make some chant up that magically makes u reappear to us,healthy as an ox....so, I go on, at least knowing 4 certain how much u loved me being ur li'l sis...sure, during this stupid gr
